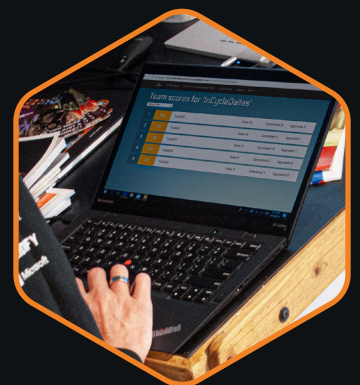
You can choose between three out of the box experience themes. We can also customize it and make it a multi-day event with challenges from all three themes.

Experience 1

FROM ONCE A MONTH TO MULTIPLE TIMES A DAY

The focus during this experience is to learn how to implement DevOps in a team so you can move from a release cadence of weeks or months to any time in the day. The day starts with a Keynote provided by Buck Hodges (Director of Software Engineering at Microsoft). At the moment of recording Buck was in charge of running Microsoft's Azure DevOps service in the cloud. In this Keynote, he shares the story of how they took little steps to create a full DevOps run team. After the Keynote, there is a local keynote that will address the story of Parts Unlimited who are trying to move to DevOps. This story is the guidance of the rest of the day and shows the overall end to end story of the challenges the attendees will face, followed by the hands-on part, where the group form teams to compete during these challenges:

- » Creating and setting up Azure Resources
- » Setting up CI/CD Pipelines
- » Setting up quality gates in the pipelines
- » Adding approval steps
- » Zero downtime deployments
- » Adding monitoring to your application
- » Adding automated approval gates
- » Using feature toggles to separate deployment from release
- » Using containers to improve feedback cycles and delivery speed



Experience 2

YOU BUILD IT YOU RUN ~~AWAY~~ IT

The focus during this experience is to run your application in production. Where Experience 1 is focussing on the build part of DevOps, this theme will focus on the run part of DevOps. We introduce the team to Site Reliability Engineering (SRE) concepts, like Root cause analysis and Learning Retrospectives. We train the team to keep their software running and mitigate problems that can occur when running the software in production. We provide all teams with a fully running website on Azure, including the Azure DevOps delivery pipelines. You will face a set of scenarios to learn how to go through the motion of Detect, Recover, Remediate and you'll also learn how to fix issues in your own production environment. This is done in such a way the services become more stable and robust over time by adopting the continuous learning and continuous feedback strategy of DevOps.

Some of the challenges of this Bootcamp:

- » Expired Certificate
- » Credential leaked
- » Denial of Service attack
- » Flakey connections
- » Vulnerable Package in the software supply chain



Experience 3

JOIN THE DEVOPS REBELLION

This experience combines the Build and Run parts of DevOps in a storyline that resembles the book of Gene Kim, called the Unicorn Project. This Bootcamp takes you on a journey at Parts Unlimited, where you will be confronted with their initially problematic IT organization. Their teams don't have anything automated, and have a tough time to stay on top of market demand. In the initial phase of the Bootcamp, the teams will focus on the basics of modern DevOps practices. In the next stage the teams will start preparing for Black Friday.

The marketing team of Parts Unlimited has come up with a campaign that could uplift their business significantly. The teams will learn techniques like load testing, chaos engineering, and optimizing deployment pipelines in such a way that you can always deploy to production with confidence, even when you hit a problem. In the final part of this experience, the team has to to keep their website and backend systems up and running during the enormous load they get from the marketing campaign during Black Friday. You are going through real website outages and need to remediate using the Detect, Respond, and Recover steps, including the long-term solutions in order for the services to become better over time.



MIX AND MATCH

It is up to you to decide which scenario would be the best for your team to learn DevOps. Are you in the starting phase? Then you probably want to select the build part of DevOps. If you are more advanced, you might want to go for the run focus of a Bootcamp. Of course, you can mix and match a Bootcamp.
